Students are not permitted to smoke at any time on the college site or between college and home

Sanctions apply to students who are caught smoking or determined to be smoking because they were in a location or situation:-

- where other students were smoking
- or where there is clear evidence of recent smoking by students
- or that has been declared out of bounds because it has been frequented by smokers.

College sanctions:

It is expected that senior students are well aware of the rules and their transgression will be treated seriously in the first instance. At all year levels no warnings will be given and suspension will occur at the first offence. Students will be referred to quit smoking materials and support.

When it is obvious that a student has been exposed to a high level of cigarette smoke that has permeated their clothing such that it impinges on the comfort of others, they will be referred to a Year Level Coordinator or Student Counsellor for appropriate guidance.
