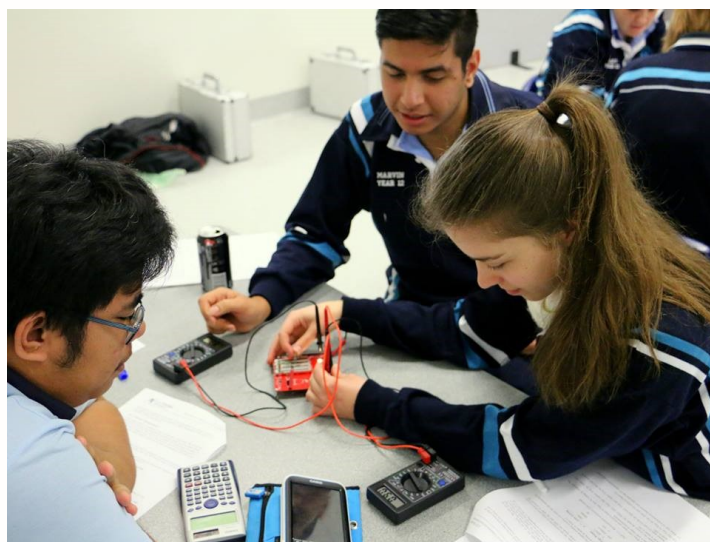
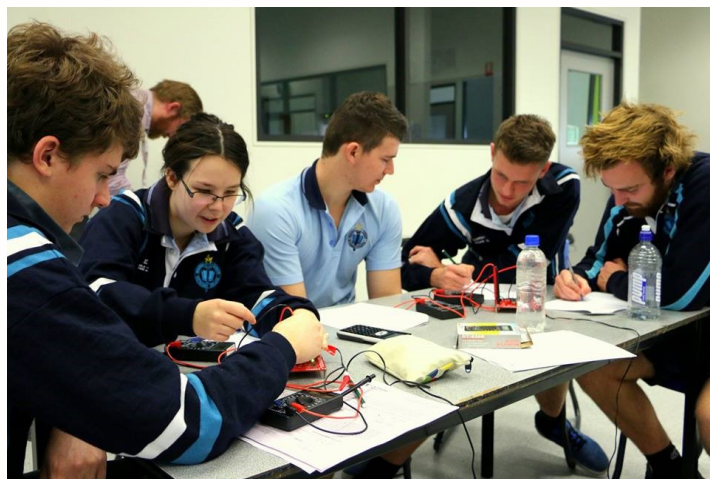
Have you considered pharmacy as a career?
