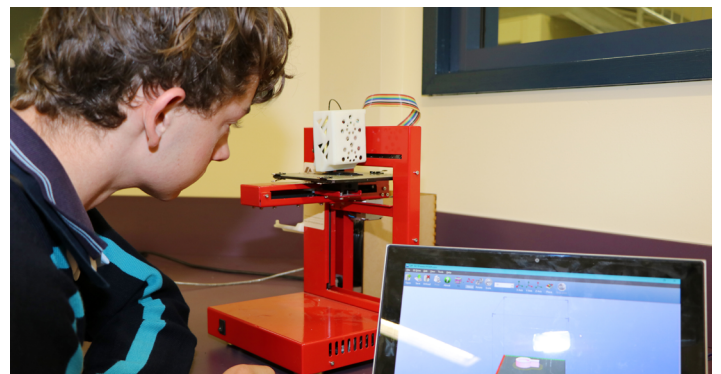


### New IT courses at Federation University, Ballarat:
