- Contact details for Teachers and Year Level Coordinators

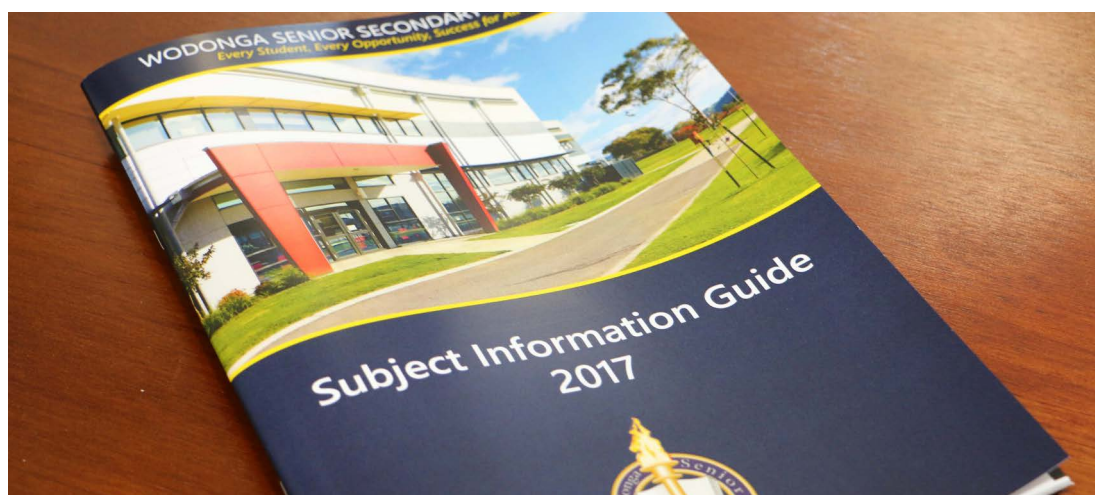

State Cross Country

Last week on Thursday 14th of July, our Cross Country team headed down for the State Championships in Bundoora, Melbourne. With our under 20's boys team consisting of Onto Le Breton, Nathan Regan, Jarrod Lewin and Aiden Shaw and two individuals Caitlyn Regan and Jovana Bukvic being chosen to represent WSSC.

Jovana Bukvic ran in the under 16 girls 3km. She had a strong run finishing 37th overall out of 85 competitors. With a nice time of 11:53 minutes, Jovana was happy she did better than last year.

Caitlyn Regan ran in the under 17-20 girls 3km. Caitlyn also ran really well and managed to stay in the top group of competitors for the whole race. In the last downhill she picked up the pace to finish 12th overall and a time of 11:16 minutes.

Onto Le Breton ran in the 17-20 boys 5km. He was first to cross the line for the team. Onto flew home finishing 18th with a time of 16:07 minutes.

Nathan finished 52nd in the middle of the pack followed by Jarrod 59th and Aiden 75th.

Everyone did their best efforts on a chilly, windy day and no rain fell luckily. They should be proud for representing WSSC at this level.
