Changes to entry requirements at Victoria University From 2017, a number of Bachelor degrees will no longer use the ATAR as the primary selection criterion for Year 12 applicants. Instead, selection will be based on specific course prerequisites and a range of other criteria. For example, a Year 12 student who completes the requirements of the VCE/HSC and achieves the prerequisite English study score will be guaranteed entry to the Bachelor of Arts.
