You are required to book in sessions with the teachers that you would like to see on the night. More information will be distributed next week.

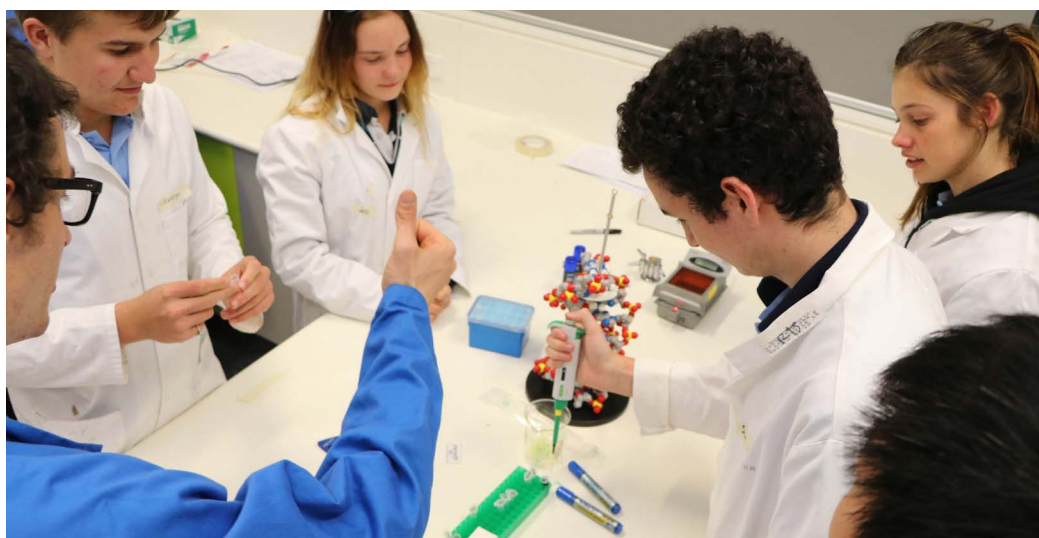
Class of 2007 Reunion
