Subject Selection Process - Key Dates

- **Week Beginning 27 July** - Students & parents/carers Visit Wodonga Senior Secondary College Subject Information website <https://subjectinfo.wssc.vic.edu.au> to learn about core & elective subjects available in Year 10
- **Tuesday, 11, August** - Students attend a Year 9 MS Teams Assembly with subject teachers from Wodonga Senior Secondary College.
- **Friday, 14, August** – Students return Completed draft Subject Selection forms to your CARE teacher. After individual discussion with Care teacher, students will log on & select chosen subjects online & print out sheet.
- Parents/Carers to sign student's selected subjects sheet.
- **Monday, 24, August** – Return signed subject selection form to CARE teacher.

Year 10 Structure

Below is an outline of the Year 10 program that each student will complete. This includes 5 core subjects of English, Mathematics, Humanities/AVID/Language, Science/AVID/Language, Graduate Program & 2 Elective Subjects.

Students are required to select two electives and two back-up electives in case their first preference clashes with another chosen subject in their program.

*Please note the Advanced Subjects are for those students currently in the Academic Advancement Program (AAP) at WMYC or are intending on applying for AAP at WSSC.
