Successful tender announced for New Dual Court Stadium and Upgrade of Galvin Hall At Wodonga Senior Secondary College

- \$8 million dual court stadium and upgrade of Galvin Hall about to begin
- Tender for construction and works now awarded with construction to commence within the month
- Both spaces to be operational in the second half of 2022

Executive Principal Vern Hilditch has today announced Joss Construction will build a dual court stadium and refurnish Galvin Hall into a Performing Art Centre.

The dual stadium will include toilet and change rooms, kiosk space, umpires' rooms, store-rooms, office and first aid rooms to facilitate the wider community use, as well as, a classroom and gym/weights area.

This announcement coincides with the 50 Year Anniversary of the opening of Galvin Hall. These works will repurpose the hall into a theatre space for college use and local and visiting productions.

Once completed, the \$8 million project will provide students at the Senior College and wider community a variety of spaces for indoor sports, theatre, dance and music.

The service refurbishment and construction are expected to be completed in the second half of 2022.
