# Warranty and Accidental Damage

Frequently Asked Questions

All devices are covered by a 3 year onsite warranty with no cost for any warranty claims

Each device has the option to be covered by a 3 year Accidental Damage Policy (ADP). Any accidental damage such as broken LCD screen, broken keyboard, water damage etc. will be covered under this policy with a \$0 excess fee.

There can only be one Accidental Damage claim per calendar year from the date of purchase.

We recommend that the device is listed under your home insurance to be covered in the event of a theft.

## **Payments Options**

We have partnered with Learning with Technologies to provide Notebook Purchase portal for all students attending Wodonga Senior Secondary college in 2022. Through this partnership we have negotiated prices and formed an endorsed list of BYOD devices to suit our curriculum.

12 Month interest free plans area available and additional Health Care card discounts can be applied – Please contact the school for details around the Health Care card discounts.

If you don't have access to a computer, you are able to complete the process at the Senior College office.

## Students using privately purchased devices at WSSC

For student to have 24/7 access to all WSSC ICT resources, they must participate in an approved WSSC Notebook program. These options will have all the required classroom software (Provided free of charge by the school) and will be dynamically updated when new software is required for individual classes. All subject areas have very specific software requirements that the school has purchased site licences for, as such all students are required to bring the correct resources to class at all times.

Students are able to complement their school purchased device with a privately owned device such as a tablet computer, however devices of this type will not have the correct software and facilities needed.

# 2022 Notebook Program Options.

Wodonga Senior Secondary College has a strong curriculum based around the use of Mobile Learning Devices. The school is committed to every student having access to a notebook computer and as such have the following options available.

The **Recommended** and **Multimedia** options are the same notebook model with the same features – 2-1 tablet design, full high-definition screen with touch enable and an active pen for writing directly on the screen. However, the **Multimedia** Notebook has a faster processor, and double the memory and Hard Disk capacity over the **Recommended** option.

The **Budget** notebook, has a lower resolution screen, no touch or 2-1 features and no active pen. With the move to digital text books, we would advise against this option.

All three options have 3 years' onsite warranty. Also included is an optional Accidental Damage Policy (ADP) that will cover accidental damage such as, broken screens, keyboards, hinges etc. with a excess of \$0 for each claim (Maximum 1 claim per calendar year).

## **Recommended Option**

Following the great success of the 2-1 designed notebook over the last 5 years, we have the same style notebook on offer for 2022. This notebook has enough speed, storage capacity and screen type for use in all subject areas. In addition, with the move to digital text books, this notebook includes and active pen to allow student easy of drawing directly on the screen.

The **Lenovo Yoga L13, Core i5, 8GB, 256GB** is designed for use in a school. This device offers best-in-class durability and has won several awards for its education focused design.

With the price and durability offered, this is the recommended option for all students studying at Wodonga Senior Secondary College.

## Multimedia Option.

Presenting the same features at the "**Recommended Option**" this notebook has a faster processor, double memory and storage capacity. This extra capacity over the "**Recommended option**" is not a requirement for any subject areas at the school.

## **Budget Option**

Although a cheaper price, this option excludes some features, such as a low-resolution screen, no 2-1 tablet design, no touch screen or active pen support. As such we feel there are too many compromises for this to be a recommended device.

## WSSC Desktop Computers

We will also be keeping a fleet of High-end Desktop computers with large LCD screens. These are located around the school for use in classrooms where subjects may require access to video editing, digital photography, advance programming applications and larger LCD screens.

#### Q) What Notebook should I select?

A: The **"Recommend Option**" - Lenovo **ThinkPad L13 Yoga Touch screen – Core i5, 8GB, 256GB** is the best choice for all students. This device offers the perfect balance of performance and price, whilst offering an active pen for writing on the screen.

#### Q) What is the difference between the Recommended, Multimedia and Budget Models?

A: The **Recommended** and **Multimedia** options are the same notebook model with the same features – 2-1 tablet design, Full High-definition screen with touch enable and an active pen for writing directly on the screen. The **Multimedia** Notebook has a faster processor, and double the memory and Hard Disk capacity over the **Recommended** option. We don't believe these extra specifications are required, however this Multimedia Notebook allows students an option to have a device with larger capacity if needed.

The **Budget** notebook, has a lower resolution screen, no touch or 2-1 features and no active pen. With the move to digital text books, this isn't our recommended option.

Regardless of subjects studied, the "*Recommended option*" - ThinkPad L13 Yoga Touch screen – Core i5, 8GB, 256GB is the best choice for all students.

#### Q What financial support can the school offer?

**A**: We have worked with Learning with Technologies to provide 2 different 12 months interest free purchase options.

In addition to the 12 month interest-free options, we have established a support fund to provide a discount voucher to families with a Health Card card. There is limited funding available, so this is a first in first severed arrangement, we recommend families contact the school as soon as possible to avoid missing out.

For any family that is experiencing significate financial hardship, we have other support mechanisms in place, please contact Belinda Telford in the main school office for assistance in this area.

#### Q: Can I use my own XYZ brand notebook?

**A:** Personal notebook are not supported by the school, although they can be brought to school for use as a reference device. Only notebooks purchased through the WSSC BYOD Purchasing portal will be compatible with all the software and services provided by the school. These devices have been specifically selected and tested to fulfil the following categories.

- Compatible with the WSSC Wireless network
- 3 Year onsite Warranty including Accidental damage (To cover broken screens, keyboards, etc.).
- Battery capacity to enable the device to be used for the full school day without being charged.
- Protected with enterprise level Anti-Virus and Malware protection
- · Access to crucial subject specific licensed software titles.
- Bulk and Education discount pricing
- Onsite stock of repair parts and standby loan notebooks.
- Backup facilities to the WSSC Network
- Designed for Student use over a 3 year period

• Automatic Backup of all school documents. Work saved on your notebook is instantly available on the school desktops and vice versa.

#### Q: What access do students have on the notebook?

A: All Students are to abide by the WSSC "*Cyber Safety and Acceptable Use Agreement*" (available on the Purchase Portal and via the School Office). Students will have full administrative access to their notebook and can install any additional programs they want, provided it is in line with the "*Cyber Safety and Acceptable Use Agreement*"

#### Q: When will the notebooks be supplied?

**A:** Your notebook will be delivered directly to the school. We will complete initial checks and install all WSSC software that is required, then contact families to arrange a pickup time.

Delivery dates will depend on when you have purchased your notebook.

• For purchases made before the 5th of November 2021, your notebook should be ready for delivery before Christmas.

• Orders placed after the 5th of November, your notebook should be ready on the first day of 2022, or around 4 weeks after the order has been placed in 2022

There are large supply issues for notebook based around COVID issues, Computer Chip Shortages, and freight issues. Because of these constraints, the above timelines can change at any point.

We strongly recommend completing your Notebook purchase ASAP to lock in a device.

#### Q: What happens when you leave the school?

**A:** The notebook is yours to keep. Any remaining onsite warranty will still be valid anywhere in Australia. It will however need to have the schools software removed and returned to the factory settings.

#### **Q: What is the accidental Damage Cover?**

**A:** Accidental Damage is an insurance policy that will cover damage to your notebook that is deemed accidental. This might include broken: LCD screens, latches, hinges, speakers, keyboard, etc. Damage that is deemed non-accidental will not be covered by this policy. A Product Disclosure Statement (PDS) can be found on the purchasing portal page for this product. Currently One Accidental damage claim can be processed each year.

We strongly recommend all families leave this option enabled when completing their purchase.

#### Q: What cost is there for an Accidental damage claim?

**A:** There is a \$0 excess fee for each damage claim, with a maximum of 1 claim per calendar year from the date of purchase.
