WSSC Term 2 End of Semester Exam Timetable

- All listed exams are compulsory to attend for all year levels, regardless of your program or intention of sitting the VCE exams.
- Students may wear casual clothes for all exams.
- No classes will be running during exam week.
- You do not need to be at school when you don't have an exam
- VCAL students will have interviews scheduled during the week please see your PD teacher for your schedule. VCAL students are required to sit any exams for subjects listed in which they are enrolled.
- Students must remain in the exam room for the full scheduled time of their exam.
- If you are sick or otherwise **unable to attend**, please discuss your catch ups with your Classroom Teacher and House Leaders.
- Friday the 24th June is put aside for catch up exams only. If you have completed all of your exams before Friday then you are not required at school that day. If you have not completed all your exams you will be required to come in on Friday and finish them all.

How to read the timetable:

- Find the timetable for the Unit level that is relevant to you (Unit 3; Unit 2; Year 10; or a combination of these if where applicable).
- The start and end time of the exams are listed in **black bolded** text.
- The subject area of the exams is listed in **red bolded** text
- The rooms you need to go to are listed in <u>underlined</u> text under the red text
- For Unit 3 exams:
 - All subjects with multiple classes are scheduled at the same time, therefore you do not need to look for your particular teacher's name. I.e.: the 3 Biology classes are scheduled at the same time in the same room and are therefore only listed once as 'Unit 3 Biology'.
 - All Unit 3 English subjects are scheduled for the Monday morning. There are no other Unit 3 exams running at this time.
 - o All Unit 3 Further Maths classes are scheduled for Tuesday afternoon. There are no other Unit 3 exams running at this time.
 - Some students have clashes between 2 exams. Where I have noticed this I have already rescheduled one of your exams. To find this, your name will be listed with the subject and room to attend under another time slot.
- For Unit 2 exams:
 - o All Unit 2 English subjects and classes are scheduled at the same time on Monday morning. No other Unit 2 subject exams will run at this time.
 - All Unit 2 General Maths subjects and classes are scheduled at the same time on Tuesday morning. No other Unit 2 subject exams will run at this time.
 - All other Unit 2 classes are scheduled with the blocking times that they run on your timetable. You will be able to find your class by paying attention to the headings in red bolded text that tell you the periods the class runs. I.e.: Unit 2 Electives (Tue P1/Wed P4/Fri P2)

- Your teacher's name will also appear next to the subject name to assist you in finding the exam.
- Unit 2 exams will only run during the mornings and afternoons there are no midday exams for Unit 2.
- Some students have clashes between 2 exams. Where I have noticed this, I have already rescheduled one of your exams. To find this, your name will be listed with the subject and room to attend under another time slot.
- For Year 10 exams
 - All Year 10 English classes will run at the same time on Monday afternoon.
 - o All Year 10 Maths classes will run at the same time on Tuesday morning.
 - All Year 10 Humanities classes will run at the same time on Wednesday afternoon.
 - All Year 10 Science classes will run at the same time on Thursday morning.
 - All other Year 10 classes are scheduled with the blocking times that they run on your timetable. You will be able to find your class by paying attention to the headings in red bolded text that tell you the periods the class runs. I.e.: Year 10 Electives (Tue P1/Wed P4/Fri P2)
 - Your teacher's name will also appear next to the subject name to assist you in finding the exam.
 - There are 3 scheduled sessions for year 10 exams on Wednesday and Thursday morning; midday; and afternoon. Only 2 sessions are scheduled for Monday and Tuesday morning and afternoon.
 - Some students have clashes between 2 exams. Where I have noticed this, I have already rescheduled one of your exams. To find this, your name will be listed with the subject and room to attend under another time slot.
