Delivery & Setup

Order by 1 November 2026: Your notebook should be ready for pickup during the 2027 Head Start program.

Orders after 1 November: Your notebook will be prepared for collection as soon as possible, with availability expected around the beginning of the 2027 school year.

All devices are delivered to the school, where we'll install the required software and notify you when the notebook is ready for pickup.

2027 Notebook Program Options.

Wodonga Senior Secondary College has a strong curriculum based on the use of mobile learning devices. The school is committed to every student having access to a notebook computer and offers the following options:

Recommended Notebooks (Option 1 & 2)– Preferred option for all students, regardless of subjects studied

Multimedia Notebook – Option 3– Higher specifications and cost. Not required for any WSSC subject, but provides additional performance and capacity.

All options have 3 years onsite warranty. Also included is an Accidental Damage Policy (ADP) that will cover damage such as broken screens, keyboards, hinges, water damage etc. with a zero cost excess.

Recommended Options

The **Lenovo Yoga 13w**, Core 5, 16GB (**Option 1**), is designed for school use. It offers strong durability and has won several awards for its education-focused design. With the move to digital textbooks, it also includes an active pen for writing and drawing directly on the screen.

With its balance of performance, durability and price, this is the recommended option for all students at Wodonga Senior Secondary College.

Additionally, we offer the **Asus BR1402C** as a lower-cost notebook option. It features a non-touchscreen display and lower specifications than the Lenovo Yoga 13w

Multimedia - Option 3

Offering increased features over the Recommended options, this notebook has a faster processor, additional capacity and a large screen. These extra features are not required for any WSSC subject.

WSSC 2027 Managed Notebook Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q) What Notebook should I select?

A: The “**Recommended Option 1**” – Lenovo Yoga 13w Gen 3, Core 5, 16GB, 256GB – is the best choice for all students. It offers a strong balance of performance and price, while also providing an active pen for writing on the screen.

The **Option 2** Asus BR1402C is a lower-cost option with a larger screen, but it is not a touchscreen model and has half the storage capacity and performance of the Yoga 13w.

Q) What is the difference between the Recommended, Multimedia and Basic models?

A: The **Multimedia** (Option 3) offers additional memory, storage and performance compared to the two recommended options.

We don't believe the extra specifications of the Multimedia option are required for study at WSSC, however it provides an option for students who want additional capacity and performance.

The Basic (Option 2) notebook provides less performance, and no tablet functionality or touchscreen. It does however provide a solid budget friendly option.

Regardless of subjects studied, the “**Recommended Option 1**” – **Lenovo Yoga 13w** – is the best choice for all students. However, all options will be supported in all classes.

Q) Can I use my own XYZ brand notebook?

A: Devices purchased elsewhere may not provide the same level of compatibility, support, warranty and accidental damage protection as our notebook program. Devices in our program have been specifically selected and tested to provide:

- Compatible with the WSSC Wireless network
- 3 Year onsite Warranty including Accidental damage (To cover broken screens, keyboards, etc.).
- Battery capacity to enable the device to be used for the full school day without being charged.
- Protected with enterprise level Anti-Virus and Malware protection
- **Access to crucial subject specific licensed software titles.**
- Bulk and Education discount pricing
- Onsite stock of repair parts and standby loan notebooks.
- **Designed for Student use over a 3 year period**
- Automatic backup of all school documents. Work saved on your notebook is instantly available on the school desktops and vice versa.
- Approved for Online Exams

Q) Can I use my old WMYC Purchased Notebook?

A: Yes, we can typically reconfigure a WMYC-purchased notebook to work at WSSC.

However, this is not always the recommended option as usually the notebook will be:

- 3 years old and limited battery capacity
- not the recommended capacity and configuration for Senior based studies
- no longer covered by accidental damage policy and insurance cover

Please speak with the WSSC ICT team if this is an option you would like to explore.

Q: What is the Accidental Damage Cover?

A: Accidental Damage is an insurance policy that covers damage to your notebook that is deemed accidental. This might include broken LCD screens, latches, hinges, speakers and keyboards. A Product Disclosure Statement (PDS) can be found on the purchasing portal page.

Q: Is there a cost for an Accidental damage claim?

A: No, there is a \$0 excess policy for each damage claim.

Q: What financial support can the school offer?

A: Interest-Free Plans

Learning With Technologies offers two different 12-month interest-free purchase options via Latitude Finance and Zip Money

A: Health Care Card Discount

In addition to the 12 month interest-free options, we have established a support fund to **provide a discount voucher of \$200 - \$300 to families with a Health Care Card**. Funding is limited, so we encourage families to contact the school as early as possible.

A: NILs – No interest Loan Via Good Shepherd

Good Shepherd provide a Centrepay-backed loan of up to \$2,000 to purchase a notebook. Please contact the school office for application details.

For any family that is experiencing significant financial hardship, we have other support mechanisms in place. Please speak with us before deciding that the notebook program is outside your budget.

Q: When will the notebooks be supplied?

A: Your notebook will be delivered directly to the school. We will complete initial checks and install all required WSSC software, then contact families to arrange a pickup time.

Delivery dates will depend on when you have purchased your notebook.

- For purchases made by 1 November 2026, your notebook should be ready for pickup during the 2027 WSSC Head Start program
- Orders placed after 1 November will be prepared for pickup as soon as possible, with availability expected around the beginning of the 2027 school year

Q: What happens if something goes wrong?

A: The WSSC ICT Team is here to assist:

- We'll diagnose the problem
- If required, we'll arrange the warranty or accidental damage repair
- A loan notebook may be available while repairs are completed
- We'll help follow up the repair and get your student's device back

Q: What happens when you leave the school?

A: The notebook is yours to keep. Any remaining onsite warranty will still be valid anywhere in Australia. It will, however, need to have the school's software removed and be returned to factory settings.

Q: What access do students have on the notebook?

A: All Students are to abide by the WSSC ***"Cyber Safety and Acceptable Use Agreement"*** (available on the Purchase Portal and via the school office). Students will have full administrative access to their notebook and can install any additional programs they want, provided it is in line with the ***"Cyber Safety and Acceptable Use Agreement"***
